JOB SUMMARY

- Meets with assigned clients weekly to do assessment,
- Assists in formulating treatment plan, make referrals, and provide counseling.
- Conducts initial and ongoing assessment of client needs and progress.
- Formulates and updates individual treatment plans.
- Conducts weekly counseling with individual clients.
- Refers clients as needed
- Coordinates treatment with appropriate Therapist, Employment Counselor, and other staff on a regular basis as appropriate and/or as directed by supervisor
- Performs crisis intervention.
- Reviews assigned case files weekly.
- Reviews Comprehensive Career Guide, assessment tests, and Career Guide Summary with assigned client.
- Assures that each client is provided appropriate mental health services and utilizes program components that are consistent with the client's treatment plan
- Utilizes knowledge of counseling modalities to match the appropriate treatment to client issues.
- Monitors client's progress on therapeutic issues throughout treatment.
- Refers client to appropriate specialized issues groups.
- Refers clients, as appropriate to their individual needs, to outside resources. (e.g. medical, dental, mental health, housing, legal, social services, veterans benefits, etc.)
- Interfaces with other staff as appropriate regarding client needs and progress.
- Develops and delivers case presentations at clinical staff meetings to introduce new clients.
- Works as a team with other staff on client interventions when appropriate.
- Informs clinical staff of client's progress on an ongoing basis.
- Co-facilitates Vet Group

- Assists with Referral's to Trauma Group
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor
