- Provides initial screenings of Veteran residents and their families who request services to assess for risk factors, special needs and potential referrals.
- Coordinates referrals as appropriate for individual, group, couple and family therapy upon request.
- Provides psycho-educational group services including, but not limited to: life skills, parenting, mental health concerns, substance use, and trauma when appropriate.
- Maintains clients' clinical records in a timely and professional manner, consistent with the standard of care in the field.
